



Central Components of the Care Coordination Model



Vision

To provide high-quality, person-centered, community-based care coordination services in an integrated delivery system to achieve optimal health outcomes



Social Determinants of Health and the Shared Care Plan

ECO MAP A graphic representation that shows the systems at play in an individual’s life.

- Helps identify family, social, community and professional relationships, and highlights the quality of these connections
- Focuses on the complex ecological system that includes family and the total environment to help care team members capture and organize this complexity

DOMAIN CARDS A set of cards depicting various domains of life (mental health, transportation, nutrition, etc.) Used to assist a person and their support system in prioritizing areas of focus for the care team and Care Plan.

- Helps align the efforts of a care team with the goals, and wishes of the patient

Project DULCE (Developmental Understanding & Legal Collaboration for Everyone)



DULCE framework:

DULCE proactively addresses social determinants of health and mitigates the risk factors for early life stress *through combined efforts of pediatric, legal, and early childhood providers.*

- Launched first pilot in Lamoille County on November 1, 2015 with a partnership between the Lamoille Family Center and Appleseed Pediatrics.
- The DULCE family specialist works with a caseload of 150 families per practice for the first six months of the newborns life, and assists the families with programs such as child care, financial assistance, 3SquaresVT, counseling, or rides to appointments.
- Legal Aid offers assistance for parents when needed.



2019 DULCE Expansion

Lamoille Valley

November 1, 2015

In partnership with Appleseed Pediatrics and Lamoille Family Center, DULCE is launched. Of the 330 births in Lamoille County per year, about half will see doctors at Appleseed Pediatrics and family practitioners at Morrisville Family Health Care and Stowe Family Practice.

*Pediatric sites and parent/child center partners have been identified in Burlington, St. Albans, and Windsor and are actively working through the contracting process. Once complete, we plan to announce the sites to local communities and the media

Monitoring & Evaluation

Chapin Hall at the University of Chicago is the research partner for DULCE. DULCE sites will collect data throughout implementation and expansion to report local results as well as data for the national DULCE demonstration project.

RiseVT Amplify Grants

Grants to Support Individual & Community Resilience



- \$1500 for yoga classes with Richmond Community Kitchen to allow children to attend cooking class while parents go to yoga
- \$1500 for mindfulness expert to come to 4 kindergarten classrooms one day per week for eight weeks in Bennington




- \$1500 to Town of Elmore to match a town contribution for 100 local households to have passes to Elmore State Park
- \$1500 for a community mental health worker to serve residents of Richmond, Huntington, and Bolton.
