17	(a) No law enforcement officer shall engage in a sexual act with a person
18	whom the officer is detaining, arresting, or otherwise holding in custody or
19	who the officer knows is being detained, arrested, or otherwise held in custody
20	by another law enforcement officer.

1	(b) A person who violates subsection (a) of this section shall be imprisoned
2	for not more than five years or fined not more than \$10,000.00, or both.
