

The Department of Corrections shall collaborate with the Department of Motor Vehicles and other partners as necessary to study how the departments can provide sentenced inmates with at least one form of government identification, not to include an inmate identification card. ~~the systemic and financial barriers to ensuring that a sentenced inmate is provided with at least one form of government issued identification, not to include an inmate identification card, upon release from incarceration. The Department of Corrections will provide monthly updates to the Joint Legislative Justice Oversight Committee, and where that report shall inform the committee on the success and barriers, which may include recommendations that require legislative support.~~

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(c) Reports.

(1) On or before August 15, 2019, the Departments of Corrections and Labor shall report to the Joint Legislative Justice Oversight Committee Concerning the Departments' progress towards developing the memorandum of Understanding as required by this section.

(2) On or before December 15, 2020, the Departments of Corrections and Labor shall report to the House Committees on Commerce and Economic Development and on Corrections and Institutions and to the Senate Committees on Economic Development, Housing and General Affairs and on Institutions concerning the implementation of this section.

~~(3) The Departments of Corrections and Motor Vehicles shall report monthly to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on progress. The Department of Corrections will provide monthly updates to the Joint Legislative Justice Oversight Committee, and where that report shall inform the committee on the successes, and barriers, which may include recommendations that require legislative support.~~
