Highlights - 2019

- Implementation of VTPICS
 - ▶ Implemented July 2019 on time and on budget
 - ▶ 80% of credentials arrived within 7-10 days at launch
 - ► Administered permit exam and issued temporary permit for young Vermonter
- ▶ 100th Anniversary of DMV Enforcement & Safety Division
 - ▶ Division established in 1919, with sole inspector responsible for entire state
 - ► Celebrated 100-year anniversary at the State House on June 14, 2019
 - ► Featured historical presentation from Lt. Gene Cote and display of memorabilia at 120 State St.
 - Created 100th Anniversary license plate for DMV trucks
- New Americans Partnership with US Committee on Refugees & Immigrants Vermont
 - ▶ Identified forms to be translated and languages to be translated into Arabic, Burmese, English, French, Kirundi, Nepali, Serbo-Croatian, Somali, Spanish and Swahili
 - Delivered training to all DMV staff on civility and unconscious bias





Highlights - 2019

- CDL Preparedness
 - ► Resolved hundreds of convictions received from other jurisdictions on Vermont drivers from previous years dating back to 2017 as result of NH crash
- Periodic Inspection Manual
 - ► Implemented 16 model year OBD inspection requirement in accordance with Act 59 of 2019
 - ► Completed update of DMV rule through Administrative Rule process
- Taiwan Driver License Reciprocity
 - ▶ Defined process for determining comparability of testing requirements
 - Entering agreement with Taiwan allow reciprocal exchange of licenses between jurisdictions
 - Reviewed testing requirements determined their testing exceeded Vermont standards

Highlights - 2019

- ► Finance & Logistics Best Practices
 - Developed and implemented new cash/check handling procedures
 - Increased presence in branch offices to perform check audits
 - Implemented use of accountability analytics (tracking over/shorts)
- Incarcerated Vermonters
 - ▶ Developed MOU in partnership with Department of Corrections to allow DMV to issue nondriver IDs to individuals being released
- Staff Training
 - ► Continued to enhance and developed online training programs

Initiatives - 2020

- VTPICS
 - ▶ Online driver license/ID card renewals April 2020
 - ► Increase access to self-service throughout branch offices
- ► CVO System Replacement
 - ► Staff and Stakeholder testing and training February-April 2020
 - ► Go live May 2020
 - ▶ Used to collect IFTA/IRP, fuel and other taxes
 - ► Transition from paper-based to online submissions for fuel tax payment
- ► Commercial Vehicle Information Exchange Window (CVIEW) Project:
 - ► Centralized dashboard creates and displays thorough motor carrier profile
 - Aggregates information gathered from various state and federal databases
 - Receives data from roadside inspection program
- Roadside Inspection System
 - ▶ Used to collect driver, vehicle, carrier and cargo compliance information at roadside
 - ▶ Data is shared with Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration

Initiatives - 2020

- National Motor Vehicle Title Information System (NMVTIS)
 - ▶ In accordance with 49 C.F.R. §30502, Vermont must make titling information available for use in operating NMVTIS
 - Designed to protect consumers from fraud and unsafe vehicles and to keep stolen vehicles from being resold
 - Vermont is one of 6 remaining states in development and was awarded \$123,040 grant for implementation
- New Americans
 - ▶ Offer forms and exams in 10 languages
 - Create and implement procedures for use of interpreters on road exam
 - ▶ Develop refresher training program for all DMV staff on cultural humility, public perception of government interaction and utilization of interpreter services
- Core System Modernization
 - ▶ By 2025, develop a plan, and begin replacement of outdated core systems and solutions, reducing risk to the state.
