3	REPORT
4	(a) Creation. There is created the Legislative Study Committee on
5	Wetlands to clarify State wetlands statutes and permitting under the statutes.
6	(b) Membership. The Legislative Study Committee on Wetlands shall be
7	composed of the following members:
8	(1) two current members of the Senate Committee on Agriculture, who
9	shall be appointed by the Committee on Committees;
10	(2) two current members of the Senate Committee on Natural Resources
11	and Energy, who shall be appointed by the Committee on Committees;
12	(3) two current members of the House Committee on Agriculture and
13	Forestry, who shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House; and
14	(4) two current members of the House Committee on Natural Resources,
15	Fish and Wildlife, who shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House.
16	(c) Assistance. The Legislative Study Committee on Wetlands shall have
17	the administrative, technical, and legal assistance of the Office of Legislative
18	Council and the Joint Fiscal Office.
19	(d) Report. On or before January 15, 2020, the Legislative Study
20	Committee on Wetlands shall submit a written report to the General Assembly
21	to update and clarify the requirements for the regulation of wetlands under
22	State statute. The Study Committee shall submit the report in the form of draft
23	legislation and shall include:

1	(1) whether the definition of "wetlands" should be amended, including
2	whether the definition of wetlands under State wetlands law should be based
3	on objective criteria such as size or location;
4	(2) the standard by which the State shall review a permit application for
5	the disturbance of a wetland or wetland buffer;
6	(3) proposed exemptions from regulation under State wetlands law for
7	specific activities, including:
8	(A) whether land on which farming or a subset of farming is
9	conducted should be excluded from the definition of "wetlands" subject to
10	State regulation or should be exempt from wetlands permitting under State
11	law; and
12	(B) whether the exemptions under State wetlands law should be
13	consistent or similar to the exemptions under federal wetlands law; and
14	(4) proposed permitting fees for wetlands permits.
15	(f) Meetings.
16	(1) The Office of Legislative Council shall call the first meeting of the
17	Legislative Study Committee on Wetlands to occur on or before August 1,
18	<u>2019.</u>
19	(2) The Legislative Study Committee on Wetlands shall select a chair
20	from among its members at the first meeting.
21	(3) A majority of the Legislative Study Committee on Wetlands shall
22	constitute a quorum.

1	(4) The Legislative Study Committee on Wetlands shall cease to exist
2	on January 15, 2020.
3	(g) Compensation and reimbursement. For attendance at meetings during
4	adjournment of the General Assembly, a legislative member of the Legislative
5	Study Committee on Wetlands shall be entitled to per diem compensation and
6	reimbursement of expenses pursuant to 2 V.S.A. § 406 for not more than six
7	meetings. These payments shall be made from monies appropriated to the
8	General Assembly.
