Act No. 15 (H.151). Health; vital records generally

An act relating to vital records, mausoleums and columbaria, and emergency health orders

This act amends statutes related to vital records, mausoleums and columbaria, and the service of emergency health orders to:

(1) authorize State agencies and grandchildren to request certified copies of birth and death certificates from the State Registrar;

(2) remove the requirement that town clerks replace and dispose of original copies after the correction, completion, or amendment of birth or death certificates;

(3) remove the requirement that the Department of Health approve the construction of mausoleums and columbaria; and

(4) allow health officers to deliver in-person service of emergency health orders.
