Subject: Labor; employment practices; minimum wage

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to amend the minimum wage set forth in 21 V.S.A. § 384 to include a calculation for the amount expended by each employer to provide an employee with health insurance. The minimum wage for each employee shall be reduced by a prorated amount based on the employer's annual cost to provide him or her with health insurance coverage up to a maximum reduction equal to the full annual cost of the premium for the lowest cost silver-level plan available through the Vermont Health Benefit Exchange.
