8	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require that, at
9	the request of the committee to which a bill, resolution, or amendment is
10	referred, the Office of Legislative Counsel prepare a racial impact statement
11	for each proposed bill, resolution, or amendment that impacts pretrial
12	detention, sentencing, probation, or parole, or establishes a new crime or
13	modifies an existing crime or the penalties associated with a crime. The racial
14	impact statements shall include: 1) an assessment of the potential impact of
15	the proposed legislation on racial and ethnic minorities, including whether it is
16	likely to have a disproportionate or unique impact on the racial and ethnic
17	communities in the State and the rationale for the impact; 2) a statistical
18	analysis of how the legislation would affect racial and ethnic minorities; 3) the
19	impact of the legislation on correctional facilities; 4) the anticipated effect of
20	the legislation on public safety in racial and ethnic communities in the State;
21	and 5) an estimate of the number of criminal cases per year that the legislation

1	would affect. The bill also proposes to require that the sponsor of the
2	legislation offer an amendment to the bill if the General Assembly finds that
3	proposed legislation has a disparate impact on members of racial minority
4	groups.
