Sec. 2. 23 V.S.A. § 1400e is added to read:
§ 1400e. EXCEPTION FOR DISABLED VEHICLES BEING TOWED
(a) A combination of vehicles including a wrecker towing one or more
disabled vehicles with a total gross vehicle weight exceeding the weight
limitations imposed by article 1 of this subchapter may be operated on a public
highway in this State without a permit, provided that:
(1) neither the wrecker nor disabled vehicle or vehicles individually
exceed the weight limitations imposed by article 1 of this subchapter or are
lawfully operating under a blanket permit;
(2) there are enough axels to distribute the total gross vehicle weight at a
rate of 20,000 pounds per axel with dual wheels and 12,000 pounds per axel
with single wheels;
(3) the wrecker has a gross vehicle weight rating of at least 18,000
pounds and is equipped with air brakes if the disabled vehicle or vehicles are
also equipped with air brakes;
(4) the wrecker is equipped with flashing, rotating, or oscillating amber
signal lamps that are visible for at least 500 feet in all directions;
(5) the wrecker utilizes the lighting and braking system of the disabled
vehicle or vehicles; and

(6) the total trip distance does not exceed 75 miles.

This act shall take effect on passage.

1	(b) The operator of the wrecker operating pursuant to this section must
2	abide by all speed limitations and posted bridge and highway weight
3	limitations and may not exceed 45 miles per hour if the gross vehicle weight is
4	90,000 pounds or greater.
