19	(8) To regulate or prohibit the use or discharge, but not possession, of

firearms within the municipality or specified portions thereof, provided that an

1	ordinance adopted under this subdivision shall be consistent with section 2295
2	of this title and shall not prohibit, reduce, or limit discharge at any existing
3	sport shooting range, as that term is defined in 10 V.S.A. § 5227.
