Subject: State buildings; energy; renewable heating system

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require the
Department of Buildings and General Services, beginning in FY 2023, to only
install non-fossil-fuel heating systems as the primary heating source in
buildings owned or controlled by the Department. The bill also proposes to
allow the Department to use a fossil-fuel system as a backup if a non-fossil-
fuel heating system is not available.
