7	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to clarify the
8	requirements for a property to be eligible for the public, pious, or charitable
9	use exemption from property tax. This bill would codify in statute existing
10	case law definitions and conditions of public, pious, or charitable use that a
11	property must meet to be exempt. This bill would also provide for a uniform,
12	statewide process to determine eligibility as a public, pious, or charitable use
13	property and appeal those determinations at the State level. Taxpayers would
14	be able to appeal to either the Director of Property Valuation and Review at the
15	Department of Taxes or the Superior Court of the county in which the property
16	is located.
