13	State employee's or teacher's base contribution that is equal to the assumed
14	rate of return plus one-half percent if the average investment performance of
15	the respective Funds over the past two fiscal years is less than the target based
16	on the actuarial value of assets, (3) adjust member contribution rates in the
17	State Employees' Retirement System and the Teachers' Retirement System to
18	reflect the results of the most recent experience study, (4) require experience
19	studies for the Vermont State Employees' Retirement System and the Vermont
20	Teachers' Retirement System at least once every three years, (5) annually
21	appropriate \$10,000,000.00 in general funds to the State Employees'

3	definition of "education spending" in 16 V.S.A. § 4001 to include the normal
