Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to clarify the
employees eligible to take crime victims' leave.

An act relating to leave for crime victims

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 21 V.S.A. § 472c is amended to read:

§ 472c. LEAVE; CRIME VICTIMS

(a) As used in this section:

* * *

(2) "Employee" means a person who ~~is a crime victim as defined in~~
~~section 495d of this chapter and~~, in consideration of direct or indirect gain or
profit, has been continuously employed by the same employer for a period of
six months for an average of at least 20 hours per week.

* * *

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on passage.
