9	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require
10	motorboats to display an aquatic invasive species decal, which shall be issued
11	after payment of an annual fee, and the State to erect signage about aquatic
12	nuisances.
13	An act relating to an aquatic invasive species decal
14	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
15	* * * Aquatic Invasive Species Decal; Education * * *
16	Sec. 1. 23 V.S.A. § 3328 is added to read:
17	§ 3328. AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES; DECAL; EDUCATION
18	(a) Fee; reciprocity.
19	(1) Motorboats registered in Vermont. The owner of the following shall
20	pay an annual aquatic invasive species decal fee of \$20.00:

1	(A) a motorboat required to be registered by this State under section
2	3305 of this title;
3	(B) a motorboat of less than 10 horsepower used as a tender to a
4	motorboat required to be registered by this State under section 3305 of this
5	<u>title; or</u>
6	(C) a motorboat that is exempt from Vermont numbering provisions
7	under section 3307 of this title that the owner expects will only be operated in
8	the waters of this State during the applicable calendar year.
9	(2) Motorboats registered in another state or country. The owner of the
10	following shall pay an annual aquatic invasive species decal fee of \$40.00 if
11	the motorboat is used in the waters of this State for any amount of time:
12	(A) a motorboat that has been registered in another state under a
13	federally approved numbering system, or that has a valid document issued by
14	the U.S. Coast Guard, U.S. Customs and Border Protection, or any other
15	federal agency; or
16	(B) a motorboat that is exempt from Vermont numbering provisions
17	under section 3307 of this title that the owner expects will be operated in the
18	waters of another state at least once during the applicable calendar year.
19	(3) Reciprocity. Notwithstanding subdivision (2) of this subsection,
20	motorboats operating in interstate waters shared with another state or province
21	shall be exempt from the requirements in subdivision (2) of this subsection if

1	they display the equivalent aquatic invasive species decal issued by the other
2	state or province. The provisions of this subdivision shall not be valid unless
3	the other state or province enacts legislation that is substantially the same as
4	the decal requirements in this section and gives reciprocal exemptions to
5	motorboats displaying the Vermont aquatic invasive species decal.
6	(b) Issuance and expiration. Upon receipt of the aquatic invasive species
7	decal fee, the Commissioner shall issue an aquatic invasive species decal,
8	which shall be issued in a new color each year and prominently display the
9	year of applicability and that it expires on December 31 in the year of
10	applicability.
11	(c) Display. The aquatic invasive species decal shall be displayed three
12	inches ahead of the validation sticker or registration number on the port side of
13	the motorboat.
14	(d) Expiration. The aquatic invasive species decal shall, without regard to
15	transfer of ownership of the motorboat, expire on December 31 in the year for
16	which it is issued.
17	(e) Education. The Commissioner shall enclose with every permanent and
18	temporary motorboat registration, registration renewal certificate, validation
19	sticker, registration reminder, and aquatic invasive species decal issued
20	pursuant to this chapter a pamphlet, based on current aquatic nuisance threats
21	and spread prevention methods, regarding the danger of aquatic nuisances,

1	how aquatic nuisance species are spread, how spread of aquatic nuisance
2	species may be controlled, safeguards required under 10 V.S.A. § 1454, and
3	requirements pertaining to the aquatic invasive species decal.

11	and spread prevention methods, regarding the danger of aquatic nuisances,

14	requirements pertaining to the aquatic invasive species decal.
15	(2) The Secretary of Transportation and Commissioner of Fish and
16	Wildlife shall ensure that signage regarding aquatic nuisances is prominently
17	posted at public access points to public waters of the State and entrances and
18	exits to limited access highways, as defined in 19 V.S.A. § 1(25).

9	Sec. 4. WARNINGS IN 2023
10	In 2023, law enforcement officers shall not issue civil violations for failure
11	to display an aquatic invasive species decal as required under 23 V.S.A. § 3328
12	as added by Sec. 1 of this act. Instead, law enforcement officers shall issue
13	warnings for failure to display an aquatic invasive species decal and provide
14	copies of the aquatic invasive species pamphlet required under 23 V.S.A.
15	§ 3328(e) as added by Sec. 1 of this act to the operator of any motorboat that is
16	observed in the waters of this State without displaying an aquatic invasive
17	species decal.
