5	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes an outline of the
6	initial districts of the House of Representatives.
7 8	An act relating to reapportioning the initial districts of the House of Representatives
9	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
10	Sec. 1. LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS; INTENT
11	(a) Legislative Findings. The General Assembly finds that:
12	(1) Pursuant to 17 V.S.A. § 1903, the State uses the U.S. decennial
13	census data to reapportion the House of Representatives and the Senate.
14	(2) The U.S. Census Bureau delayed its release of the Vermont
15	redistricting dataset of the 2020 United States decennial census by
16	approximately five months in 2021, which resulted in significant delays in the
17	start of the State's reapportionment process.
18	(3) In recognition of the Legislative Apportionment Board's inability to
19	meet the August 15, 2021 reapportionment submission deadline imposed
20	pursuant to 17 V.S.A. §§ 1905, 1906, and 1907 because of the delayed dataset

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1	release, in 2021 Acts and Resolves No. 11 the General Assembly authorized
2	the Legislative Apportionment Board to submit is final proposals for the
3	reapportionment of the House and the Senate not later than 90 days from the
4	date of the U.S. Census Bureau released the Vermont redistricting dataset of
5	the 2020 United States decennial census.
6	(4) The Legislative Apportionment Board submitted its final House
7	proposal to the Clerk of the House on November 30, 2021, significantly later
8	than the customary submission date of August 15 in prior reapportionment
9	cycles. The Chair of the Legislative Apportionment Board presented to the
10	House Committee on Government Operations on December 8, 2021, regarding
11	the Board's work on the adopted House proposal and the alternate House
12	proposal. The Legislative Apportionment Board did not finalize and approve
13	its written report to the General Assembly regarding its adopted House
14	proposal and alternate House proposal until January 5, 2022.
15	(5) In recent reapportionment cycles, the House committee of
16	jurisdiction has held hearings throughout the State during the fall, after the
17	submission of the Legislative Apportionment Board's final House proposal, to
18	hear from cities and towns on both the Board's House proposal and on any
19	other redistricting matters.
20	(6) Due to the U.S. Census Bureau's delayed release of the 2020
21	redistricting dataset, and the resulting delay for the Legislative Apportionment

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1	Board's work, the House Committee on Government Operations has not been
2	able to complete its customary reapportionment work prior to the beginning of
3	the legislative session.
4	(b) Intent. It is the intent of the General Assembly to propose the initial
5	district plan described in this act to cities, towns, and boards of civil authority
6	as a starting point to receive testimony and feedback on the reapportionment of
7	the House of Representatives. The initial district plan described in this act is
8	not intended to describe any final district lines for the 2022 reapportionment of
9	the House of Representatives. It is the intent of the General Assembly that the
10	House Committee on Government Operations conduct public hearings, take
11	testimony from boards of civil authority, and request feedback on district lines
12	from cities and towns prior to the General Assembly's enactment of final
13	district lines.
14	Sec. 2. REAPPORTIONMENT; INITIAL HOUSE DISTRICTS PLAN
	(a) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the House
	Committee on Government Operations shall send the multi-member districts
	reapportionment proposal submitted by the Legislative Apportionment Board
	to the Clerk of the House on January 6, 2022, and the all single-member
	districts reapportionment proposal submitted by the Legislative Apportionment
	Board to the Clerk of the House on November 30, 2021, to cities, towns, and

boards of civil authority for purposes of taking testimony and requesting

feedback on the reapportionment of the House of Representatives prior to the enactment of final districts.

(b) Notwithstanding 17 V.S.A. § 1893 or any other provision of law to the contrary, the following shall be the initial district reapportionment plan proposed to cities and towns for purposes of receiving proposals for subdivision of districts under 17 V.S.A. §§ 1906b–1906c:
