13	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to change the
14	name of the Department of Public Safety, Division of Fire Safety, to the
15	Division of Fire and Building Safety and give it jurisdiction over the
16	implementation of Vermont's energy codes, the Residential Building Energy
17	Standards (RBES), and the Commercial Building Energy Standards (CBES).
18	Currently, the Division has jurisdiction over all other codes related to building
19	safety, but the Public Service Department (PSD) develops and maintains the
20	RBES and CBES. The Division and the PSD shall coordinate as necessary to
21	administer and update Vermont's energy codes. The Division's jurisdiction

1	currently covers all "public buildings," except single-family owner-occupied
2	houses. This bill would provide for additional staff and an appropriate fee
3	structure to encompass the Division's expanded jurisdiction over both energy
4	codes and single-family housing.
