11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
12	Sec. 1. ADULT DAY SERVICES; PAYMENT REFORM
13	METHODOLOGIES; REPORT
14	The Department of Disabilities, Aging, and Independent Living (DAIL),
15	Adult Services Division, in collaboration with the Department of Vermont
16	Health Access (DVHA) and representatives of adult day service providers,
17	shall explore options for creating a transparent, effective, predictable,
18	sustainable, and administratively feasible payment model for adult day service
19	providers that will enable older Vermonters and their caregivers to have and
20	maintain access to adult day services in their communities. On or before

1	January 15, 2023, DAIL shall provide to the House Committees on Human
2	Services and on Appropriations and the Senate Committees on Health and
3	Welfare and on Appropriations the findings and recommendations from its
4	collaboration with DVHA and the representatives of adult day service
5	providers, including identifying the payment model or methodologies that the
6	collaborators determined to be the most transparent, effective, predictable,
7	sustainable, and administratively feasible and a proposed timeline for its
8	implementation.
9	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
10	This act shall take effect on passage.
