13	§ 1734a. LICENSE BY ENDORSEMENT
14	(a) The Board shall have an endorsement process for physician assistant
15	licensure that requires not more than three years of practice in good standing in
16	another jurisdiction within the United States, regardless of whether that
17	jurisdiction has licensing requirements substantially equal to those of this
18	State.
19	(b) If the Board determines that three years of demonstrated practice in
20	another specific jurisdiction is not adequately protective of the public, it shall

1	provide its rationale to the Commissioner, who may propose any necessary
2	statutory or rule amendments in order to implement more restrictive
3	requirements for endorsement for that jurisdiction.
4	(c) The Board may issue to an endorsement applicant a waiver of the
5	practice requirement if there is a showing that the waiver follows State policy
6	and the public is adequately protected.
7	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
8	This act shall take effect on January 1, 2023.
