6	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to, with limited
7	exceptions, prohibit the operation of a motor vehicle equipped with an
8	inadequate or modified muffler or exhaust system or with an amplification
9	device.
10	An act relating to excessive motor vehicle noise
11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
12	Sec. 1. 23 V.S.A. § 1221 is amended to read:
13	§ 1221. CONDITION OF VEHICLE; EXCESSIVE NOISE
14	(a) A motor vehicle, operated on any highway, shall be in good mechanical
15	condition and shall be properly equipped.
16	(b)(1) An individual may not operate a motor vehicle with an exhaust
17	system that has been modified when the result of that modification is the
18	amplification or increase of noise emitted by the motor above that emitted by
19	the muffler originally installed on the vehicle. An individual who violates this
20	subdivision shall be subject to a civil penalty of not less than:

1	(A) \$100.00 for a first violation;
2	(B) \$200.00 for a second violation; and
3	(C) \$350.00 for a third or subsequent violation.
4	(2) It shall be a defense to a violation of subdivision (1) of this
5	subsection if a muffler or exhaust system of a motor vehicle does not emit
6	noise in excess of 95 decibels as measured in accordance with SAE
7	International (SAE) standard J1492, as amended, or any subsequent standard
8	developed and implemented by SAE. Measurements must be made by a
9	participating certified inspection station.
10	(c) A motor vehicle equipped or modified as described in subdivision
11	(b)(1) of this section shall not pass an inspection required under section 1222
12	of this title.
