- 15 § 1406. TAXES EXPENDED; HOW
- 16 Upon allowance of the accounts of supervisors and appraisers for
- 17 unorganized towns and gores, the Commissioner of Finance and Management
- 18 shall certify forthwith the amount as allowed to the State Treasurer and the
- 19 balance, if any, of the monies received from any supervisor, after deducting the

1	amount of the county tax, cost of fire and rescue services provided by other
2	municipalities, and regional planning costs, if any. The amount of such
3	supervisors' and appraisers' accounts, so certified, shall be used for the laying
4	out, construction, and maintenance of highways and bridges in the unorganized
5	towns and gores for which the supervisor is appointed, to be expended by and
6	under the direction of the Secretary of Transportation, in the same manner as
7	State transportation appropriations. The portion of the money which remains
8	unexpended for more than one year may be carried forward in the supervisors'
9	accounts for like purposes.
10	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
11	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
