10	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to prohibit the
11	Secretary of Natural Resources from approving a leachate pretreatment system
12	at a landfill in Vermont. The bill would also prohibit a landfill in the State
13	from accepting landfill leachate, sludge, or contaminated soils unless the
14	Secretary of Natural Resources has issued a certification for the facility that
15	produced the landfill leachate, sludge, or contaminated soils or otherwise
16	approved the site or facility where the landfill leachate, sludge, or
17	contaminated soils originated. The bill would include a purpose section that
18	would declare that regulation of waste accepted by landfills in the State is
19	necessary in order to protect the water quality of Vermont, including Lake
20	Memphremagog and its integral importance as the largest body of water in
21	northeastern Vermont, the source of drinking water for 175,000 persons, and
22	an important economic driver for northeastern Vermont.
