5	Subject: Education; Vermont State Colleges; Board of Trustees; restructuring
6	plan and tuition program
7	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to expand and
8	reconstitute the Vermont State Colleges Board of Trustees, to require the
9	reconstituted Board to develop a restructuring plan and tuition program for the
10	Vermont State Colleges, and, on or before December 15, 2021, for the Board
11	to report its recommendations to the General Assembly.
12 13	An act relating to the reconstitution of the Vermont State Colleges Board of Trustees and the development of a restructuring plan and tuition program
14	for the Vermont State Colleges
15	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
16	* * * Board of Trustees * * *
17	Sec. 1. 16 V.S.A. § 2172 is amended to read:
18	§ 2172. TRUSTEES; APPOINTMENT; VACANCIES
19	(a) The Corporation shall be governed by a board of 15 19 trustees who
20	shall be appointed or elected as follows:

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1	(1) Biennially the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate,
2	shall appoint trustees to serve for four-year terms expiring March 1 of the year
3	of the biennial session. Five trustees may be in office at one time under this
4	subdivision. In the event of any vacancy occurring between biennial sessions
5	in an office under this subdivision, the Governor pursuant to 3 V.S.A. § 257
6	shall fill the vacancy, and the term of a person so appointed shall expire on
7	March 1 in the year of the next following biennial session. Four trustees shall
8	be full or part-time faculty of the Corporation elected by the Corporation's full
9	and part-time faculty voting at large to four-year terms expiring on March 1.
10	Vacancies for any cause shall be filled by vote of the full or part-time faculty
11	of the Corporation voting at large, and the term of the person so appointed
12	shall expire on the next following March 1.
13	(2)(A) One trustee Two trustees shall be a student trustee, each of
14	whom:
15	(i) who is a matriculated student at an educational institution
16	operated by the Vermont State Colleges Corporation;
17	(ii) who is pursuing a degree program; and
18	(iii) who has reached the age of majority.
19	(B) The Each student trustee shall serve a one-year term expiring on
20	June 1. The Each student trustee shall be appointed, and a vacancy may be

filled, from among those eligible students applying for the position by the

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1	decision of those members of the steering committee of the Vermont State
2	Colleges Student Association who have been elected at large to that committee
3	by the students at their respective colleges. No student trustee may serve more
4	than two consecutive terms.
5	(3) Four trustees shall be legislative trustees who are members of the
6	General Assembly at the time of their election. Legislative trustees shall serve
7	four-year terms expiring on March 1 of the second year of the biennial session,
8	and they shall be elected by joint assembly of the Legislature. Vacancies for
9	any cause shall be filled by the General Assembly at its earliest opportunity
10	and the term of a person so appointed shall expire on March 1 of the next even
11	numbered year.
12	(4) Four trustees shall be elected by the Board of Trustees to four-year
13	terms expiring on March 1. Vacancies for any cause shall be filled by the
14	remaining members of the Board of Trustees, and the term of the person so
15	appointed shall expire on the next following March 1.
16	(5) One trustee shall be a full or part-time librarian of the Corporation
17	appointed by the Board of Trustees to a four-year term expiring on March 1. A
18	vacancy for any cause shall be filled by the Board, and the term of the person

so appointed shall expire on the next following March 1.

(6) Two trustees shall be members of the Corporation's American

Federation of Teachers' United Professionals bargaining unit appointed by the

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1	bargaining unit to four-year terms expiring on March 1. A vacancy for any
2	cause shall be filled by the bargaining unit, and the term of the person so
3	appointed shall expire on the next following March 1.
4	(7) Two trustees shall be members of the Vermont State Employees
5	Association appointed by the Vermont State Employees Association to four-
6	year terms expiring on March 1. A vacancy for any cause shall be filled by the
7	Vermont State Employees Association, and the term of the person so appointed
8	shall expire on the next following March 1.
9	(b) Appointments by the Governor and elections <u>Elections</u> by the General
10	Assembly and faculty members shall be made with consideration of the
11	geographic distribution of members to prevent an unfair focus on any single
12	college.
13	(c) No trustee shall be a member of the Board of Trustees of the University
14	of Vermont.
15	(d)(1) The Board of Trustees, after notice and a hearing, may remove a
16	trustee for incompetency, failure to discharge duties, malfeasance, illegal acts,
17	or other cases inimical to the welfare of the Corporation.
18	(2) Gubernatorial appointed trustees shall serve at the pleasure of the
19	Governor pursuant to 3 V.S.A. § 2004.

1	(3) In the event of a vacancy occurring under this subsection, the
2	Governor or the Board the appointing party or the electors, as applicable, shall
3	fill the vacancy pursuant to subsection (a) of this section.
4	Sec. 2. 16 V.S.A. § 2173 is amended to read:
5	§ 2173. BOARD OF TRUSTEES; ORGANIZATION
6	In addition to the 14 elected and appointed trustees, the Board of Trustees
7	shall include as a member the Governor of Vermont. A majority of the trustees
8	shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. Biennially, the Board
9	shall elect one of its voting members to serve as its chair.
10	Sec. 3. TRANSITION
11	(a) The service of the Governor and the Governor's appointees on the
12	Vermont State Colleges Board of Trustees shall terminate on July 1, 2021.
13	(b) On or before July 31, 2021, new members of the Vermont State
14	Colleges Board shall be appointed or elected under Sec. 1 of this act. The first
15	year of service of these new members shall be a partial year commencing on
16	August 1, 2021 and ending on March 1, 2022. The following three years of
17	their terms shall each be a full year.
18	* * * Restructuring plan and tuition program * * *
19	Sec. 4. RESTRUCTURING PLAN AND TUITION PROGRAM; REPORT
20	On or before December 15, 2021, the Vermont State Colleges Board of
21	Trustees shall submit a written report to the General Assembly. In preparing

1	its report, the Board shall take into consideration the report entitled "Uniting
2	Vermont: A Design for a Unified Public-Access Higher Education System;
3	Labor Task Force for Public Higher Education in Vermont" proposed by
4	members of the Labor Unions of the Vermont State Colleges System, dated
5	November 2020. The Board shall make the following recommendations to the
6	General Assembly.
7	(1) How to increase access, collaboration, administrative efficiency, and
8	innovation through the development of a single unified system of public
9	postsecondary education that has a single executive office formed by the
10	consolidation of executive and upper-level administrative operations across the
11	Colleges and the elimination of the Chancellor's Office. The recommendation
12	shall assume that the Vermont State Colleges shall remain independent of the
13	University of Vermont and State Agricultural College while maintaining
14	cooperative relations with the University.
15	(2) The design of a last-dollar tuition program for Vermont residents and
16	how that program should be funded.
17	(A) The funding recommendation shall:
18	(i) include a requirement that the Vermont Student Assistance
19	Corporation cease providing scholarship or tuition assistance for Vermont
20	residents who attend college out-of-state and shall redirect those funds to the
21	Vermont State Colleges tuition program; and

1	(ii) redirect administrative savings from the Board's restructuring
2	recommendation under subdivision (1) of this section to that tuition program.
3	(B) The funding recommendation may:
4	(i) include a portion of revenue from taxes on cannabis products;
5	(ii) redirect appropriations from workforce development
6	programs; and
7	(iii) include other funding sources identified by the Board.
