16	49 C.F.R. § 571.218, as may be amended. The requirement of this section
17	shall not apply to occupants of fully enclosed autocycles.
18	(b) This section may be enforced only if a law enforcement officer has
19	detained the operator or rider of a motorcycle for another suspected traffic
20	violation. An operator or rider shall not be subject to a penalty under this

1	section unless the operator or rider is required to pay a penalty for the primary
2	violation.
