7	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to specify how
8	credit card payments are processed at electric vehicle supply equipment
9	available to the public.
10	An act relating to payment options at electric vehicle supply equipment
11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
12	Sec. 1. 30 V.S.A. § 201(2) is amended to read:
13	(2) "Electric vehicle supply equipment" means a device or system
14	designed and used specifically to transfer electrical energy to a plug-in electric
15	vehicle as defined in 23 V.S.A. § 4(85), either as \underline{a} charge transferred via a
16	physical or wireless connection, by loading a fully charged battery, or by other
17	means. "Electric vehicle supply equipment available to the public" shall:
18	(A) be located at a publicly available parking space, which does not
19	include a parking space that is part of or associated with a private residence or
20	a parking space that is reserved for the exclusive use of an individual driver,

1	vehicle, or group of drivers or vehicles including employees, tenants, visitors,
2	residents of a common interest development, residents of an adjacent building,
3	or customers of a business whose primary business is not electric vehicle
4	charging;
5	(B) disclose all charges for the use of the electric vehicle supply
6	equipment at the point of sale; and
7	(C) provide multiple payment options that allow access by the public,
8	if a fee is required, and shall not require persons desiring to use such public
9	electric vehicle supply equipment to pay a subscription fee or otherwise obtain
10	a membership in any club, association, or organization as a condition of using
11	such electric vehicle supply equipment, but may have different price schedules
12	that are conditioned on a subscription or membership in a club, association, or
13	organization means electric vehicle supply equipment that meets the
14	requirements in 23 V.S.A § 1363.

18	Electric vehicle supply equipment, as defined in 30 V.S.A. § 201(2), shall
19	meet all of the following requirements if it is available to the public:
20	(1) Be located at a publicly available parking space, which does not
21	include a parking space that is part of or associated with a private residence or

1	a parking space that is reserved for the exclusive use of an individual driver,
2	vehicle, or group of drivers or vehicles including employees, tenants, visitors,
3	residents of a common interest development, residents of an adjacent building,
4	or customers of a business whose primary business is not electric vehicle
5	charging.
6	(2) Disclose all charges for the use of the electric vehicle supply
7	equipment at the point of sale.
8	(3) If a fee is required, provide multiple payment options and not require
9	persons desiring to use such public electric vehicle supply equipment to pay a
10	subscription fee or otherwise obtain a membership in any club, association, or
11	organization as a condition of using such electric vehicle supply equipment but
12	may have different price schedules that are conditioned on a subscription or
13	membership in a club, association, or organization. If via credit card is one of
14	the payment options, then a toll-free telephone number to process the credit
15	card payment shall be prominently displayed and there may also be a way to
16	process a payment on-site, including through a contactless credit card, Europay
17	Mastercard Visa chip, or magstripe credit card reader.
18	Sec. 3. STATE REQUIREMENTS FOR EVSE FUNDING
19	Unless otherwise required by federal law, the State shall not require a
20	particular payment method in order for a person to receive State or federal
21	funding for electric vehicle supply equipment available to the public, provided

- 1 that the electric vehicle supply equipment will meet all of the conditions
- 2 required under 23 V.S.A. § 1363 as added by Sec. 2 of this act.

- 4 <u>This act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.</u>
