Whereas, Megan Nick dedicated many years to mastering this unique winter sport, earning a spot on the 2022 U.S. Winter Olympics Team, and

Whereas, skiing in a chilling minus 10 degrees, Megan Nick surprised many observers, executing a back full-double full, earning the bronze medal, and becoming the first native Vermonter, and the first American woman since 1998, to clinch a Winter Olympics medal in women's individual aerials, now therefore be it
