Senate Resolution

By the Committee on Rules,

S.R. 22. Senate resolution amending temporary Rule 10A.

Resolved by the Senate:

That Rule 10A is amended to read as follows:

Rule 10A. (a) A Senator physically entering the Senate Chamber or Senate committee room is strongly encouraged to wear a facial covering (mask) meeting the minimal requirements set by the Rules Committee.

(b) A Senator physically entering a committee room when the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention rates Washington County to be at a High COVID-19 community level shall wear a facial covering (mask) meeting the minimal requirements set by the Rules Committee. If a Senator is unable or refuses to wear a facial covering when required, the Senator shall be denied physical access to committee rooms but shall be provided with alternative electronic means to fulfil the Senator's duties.

(c) This Temporary Rule 10A shall expire on the convening of the 2023 Biennial session.
