1	TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
2	The Committee on Appropriations to which was referred House Bill No.
3	153 entitled "An act relating to Medicaid reimbursement rates for home- and
4	community-based service providers" respectfully reports that it has considered
5	the same and recommends that the report of the Committee on Human Services
6	be amended as follows:
7	First: By striking out Secs. 2, 33 V.S.A. § 911, and 3, 18 V.S.A. § 8914, in
8	their entireties and inserting in lieu thereof new Secs. 2 and 3 to read as
9	follows:
10	Sec. 2. 33 V.S.A. § 911 is added to read:
11	§ 911. PAYMENT RATES FOR PROVIDERS OF HOME- AND
12	COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES
13	(a) The Secretary of Human Services shall determine payment rates for
14	providers of home- and community-based services that are reasonable and
15	adequate to achieve the required outcomes for the populations they serve.
16	When determining these payment rates, the Secretary shall adjust the rate
17	amounts to take into account factors that include:
18	(1) the reasonable cost of any governmental mandate that has been
19	enacted, adopted, or imposed by any State or federal authority; and

1	(2) a cost adjustment factor to reflect changes in reasonable costs of
2	goods to and services of providers of home- and community-based services,
3	including those attributed to inflation and labor market dynamics.
4	(b) When determining reasonable and adequate rates of payment for
5	providers of home- and community-based services, the Secretary may consider
6	geographic differences in wages, benefits, housing, and real estate costs in
7	each region of the State.
8	(c) The Secretary shall adopt rules setting forth the methodology for
9	determining payment rates for providers of home- and community-based
10	services in accordance with this section. The rules shall include a process for
11	determining an annual inflationary rate adjustment, shall set forth a predictable
12	timeline for redetermination of base rates, and shall use Vermont labor market
13	rates and Vermont costs of operation.
14	(d) The Secretary shall redetermine the payment rates for providers of
15	home- and community-based services in accordance with this section at least
16	annually and shall report those rates, and the amounts necessary to fund them,
17	to the House Committees on Appropriations, on Human Services, and on
18	Health Care and the Senate Committees on Appropriations and on Health and
19	Welfare annually as part of the Agency's budget presentation.
20	Sec. 3. 18 V.S.A. § 8914 is amended to read:
21	§ 8914. RATES OF PAYMENTS TO DESIGNATED AND SPECIALIZED

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1	SERVICE AGENCIES
2	(a) The Secretary of Human Services shall have sole responsibility for
3	establishing determine the Departments of Health's, of Mental Health's, and of
4	Disabilities, Aging, and Independent Living's rates of payments for designated
5	and specialized service agencies that are reasonable and adequate to achieve
6	the required outcomes for designated populations. When establishing
7	determining these rates of payment for designated and specialized service
8	agencies, the Secretary shall adjust rates the rate amounts to take into account
9	factors that include:
10	(1) the reasonable cost of any governmental mandate that has been
11	enacted, adopted, or imposed by any State or federal authority; and
12	(2) a cost adjustment factor to reflect changes in reasonable costs of
13	goods to and services of designated and specialized service agencies, including
14	those attributed to inflation and labor market dynamics.
15	(b) When establishing determining reasonable and adequate rates of
16	payment for designated and specialized service agencies, the Secretary may
17	consider geographic differences in wages, benefits, housing, and real estate
18	costs in each region of the State.
19	(c) The Secretary shall adopt rules setting forth the methodology for
20	determining the payment rates for services provided by designated and
21	specialized service agencies to individuals with mental conditions, individuals
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1	with substance use disorders, and individuals with developmental or
2	intellectual disabilities in accordance with this section. The rules shall include
3	a process for determining an annual inflationary rate adjustment, shall set forth
4	a predictable timeline for redetermination of base rates, and shall use Vermont
5	labor market rates and Vermont costs of operation.
6	(d) The Secretary shall redetermine the payment rates for designated and
7	specialized agencies in accordance with this section at least annually and shall
8	report those rates, and the amounts necessary to fund them, to the House
9	Committees on Appropriations, on Human Services, and on Health Care and
10	the Senate Committees on Appropriations and on Health and Welfare annually
11	as part of the Agency's budget presentation.
12	Second: By striking out Sec. 5, effective date, in its entirety and inserting in
13	lieu thereof a new Sec. 5 to read as follows:
14	Sec. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE
15	This act shall take effect on passage, with the rules adopted by the Secretary
16	of Human Services pursuant to Secs. 2 (33 V.S.A. § 911) and 3 (18 V.S.A.
17	§ 8914) taking effect on or before July 1, 2022.
