1	TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:		
2	The Committee on Appropriations to which was referred House Bill No.		
3	360 entitled "An act relating to accelerated community broadband		
4	deployment" respectfully reports that it has considered the same and		
5	recommends that the bill be amended as follows:		
6	First: In Sec. 1, findings and intent, in subsection (a), by adding subdivision		
7	(18) to read as follows:		
8	(18) The Department of Public Service estimates that 82 percent of		
9	Vermont addresses (254,000 locations) lack access to 100 Mbps symmetrical		
10	service. The total cost to provide 100 Mbps symmetrical service to each of		
11	these locations is approximately \$1,000,000,000.00. This figure is based on		
12	estimates in the Magellan Advisors' report commissioned by the Department,		
13	and it includes estimates of both fixed and variable capital costs for fiber to the		
14	premise infrastructure (Feasibility Study of Electric Companies Offering		
15	Broadband in Vermont, dated December 31, 2019).		
16	Second: In Sec. 2, 30 V.S.A. chapter 91A, in section 8087, the Community		
17	Broadband Preconstruction Grant Program, by adding subsection (c) to read as		
18	follows:		
19	(c) To ensure the expeditious allocation of funds prior to the organization		
20	of the Vermont Community Broadband Authority, the Department of Public		

1	Service is authorized to allocate up to \$9,000,000.00 under this Program on or
2	before September 30, 2021.
3	Third: In Sec. 2, 30 V.S.A. chapter 91A, by striking out section 8088 in its
4	entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new section 8088 to read as follows:
5	§ 8088. CONSTRUCTION GRANT AND SUBORDINATED DEBT
6	<u>PROGRAM</u>
7	(a) The Authority shall establish the Construction Grant and Subordinated
8	Debt Program for communications union districts to support projects that are
9	consistent with the funding priorities established in section 8086 of this
10	chapter, including by supplementing financing under the Vermont Economic
11	Development Authority's Broadband Expansion Loan Program.
12	(b) Lending and grant decisions under this section shall be made by the
13	Vermont Community Broadband Authority Board of Directors. The Vermont
14	Economic Development Authority shall service all loans made pursuant to this
15	section. In the event of default by a loan recipient, the Vermont Economic
16	Development Authority shall consult with the Vermont Community Broadband
17	Authority prior to commencing any collection action.
18	Fourth: In Sec. 4a, position transfer, after the first sentence, by adding a
19	new second sentence to read as follows: The position shall remain in the
20	classified service created in 3 V.S.A. chapter 13.

1	<u>Fifth</u> : By striking out Sec. 23, appropriations; fund transfers, in its entirety
2	and inserting in lieu thereof a new Sec. 23 to read as follows:
3	Sec. 23. APPROPRIATIONS; GRANT ADMINISTRATION
4	(a)(1) To the extent necessary, for appropriations using federal funds
5	provided to the State by the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA), the
6	Commissioner of Finance and Management is authorized to expend the funds
7	in anticipation of receipts.
8	(2) In fiscal year 2021, to the extent permitted by federal law and
9	guidance, \$150,000,000.00 of federal funds allocated to the State by the ARPA
10	shall be appropriated as follows:
11	(A) \$30,000,000.00 to the Vermont Community Broadband Fund to
12	support the Community Broadband Preconstruction Grant Program established
13	in Sec. 2, 30 V.S.A. § 8087, of this act;
14	(B) \$120,000,000.00 to the Vermont Community Broadband Fund to
15	support the Construction Grant and Subordinated Debt Program established in
16	Sec. 2, 30 V.S.A. § 8088, of this act; and
17	(3) In fiscal year 2021, to the extent permitted by federal law and
18	guidance, \$100,000.00 of federal funds allocated to the State by the ARPA
19	shall be appropriated to the Department of Labor to support the broadband
20	occupational needs survey required by Sec. 20 of this act and the broadband
21	installer apprenticeship program established in Sec. 22 of this act as follows:

1	(A) \$3,000.00 to finance the development of the apprenticeship
2	program;
3	(B) \$90,000.00 to support the related instruction tuition and on-
4	the-job training contracts with employer-sponsors under the apprenticeship
5	program; and
6	(C) \$7,000.00 to support non-federally funded work related to
7	developing, conducting, and reporting on the occupational needs survey.
8	(c) In fiscal year 2022, the Authority is authorized to expend \$500,000.00
9	in anticipated receipts pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 7523(b) (0.4 percent of the
10	Vermont Universal Service Charge) to support the start-up costs of the
11	Vermont Community Broadband Authority.
12	(d) The Vermont Community Broadband Authority shall be redesignated as
13	the responsible entity for administering the \$1,000,000.00 grant award to the
14	Department of Public Service by the Northern Border Regional Commission
15	(NBRC) for the purpose of supporting communications union districts. Any
16	position funded by the grant shall be overseen and managed by the Authority
17	in a manner that is consistent with grant terms and conditions.
