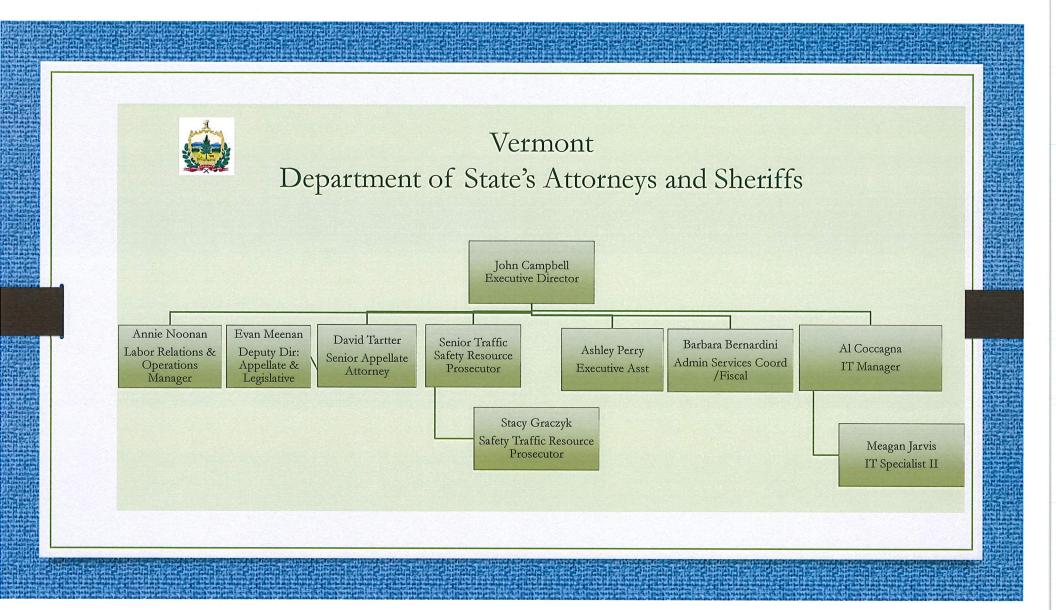

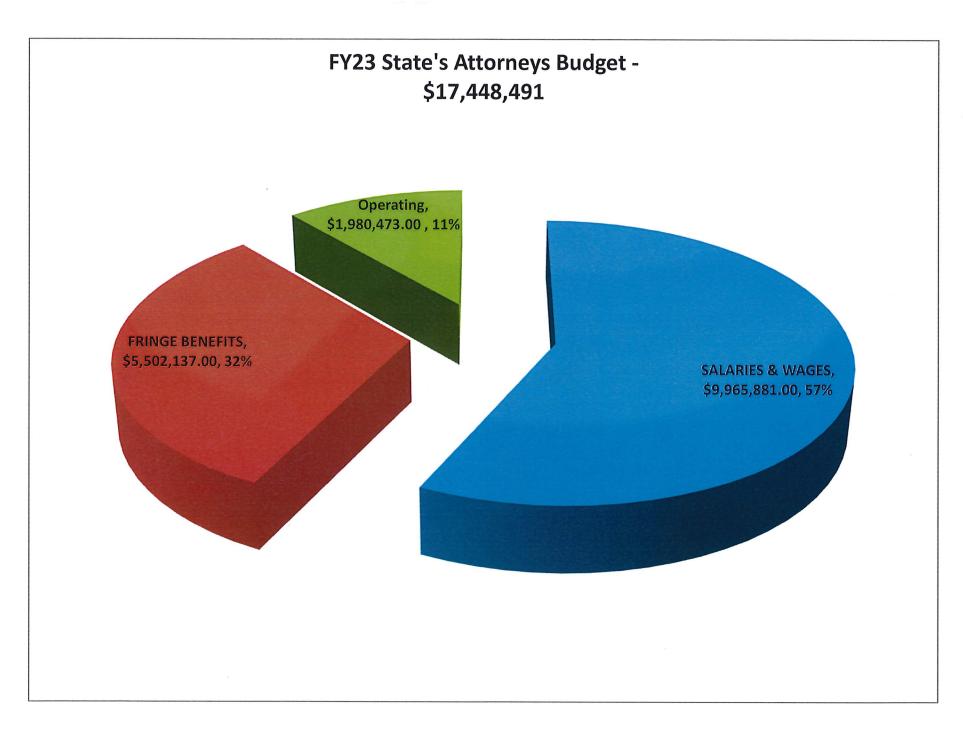

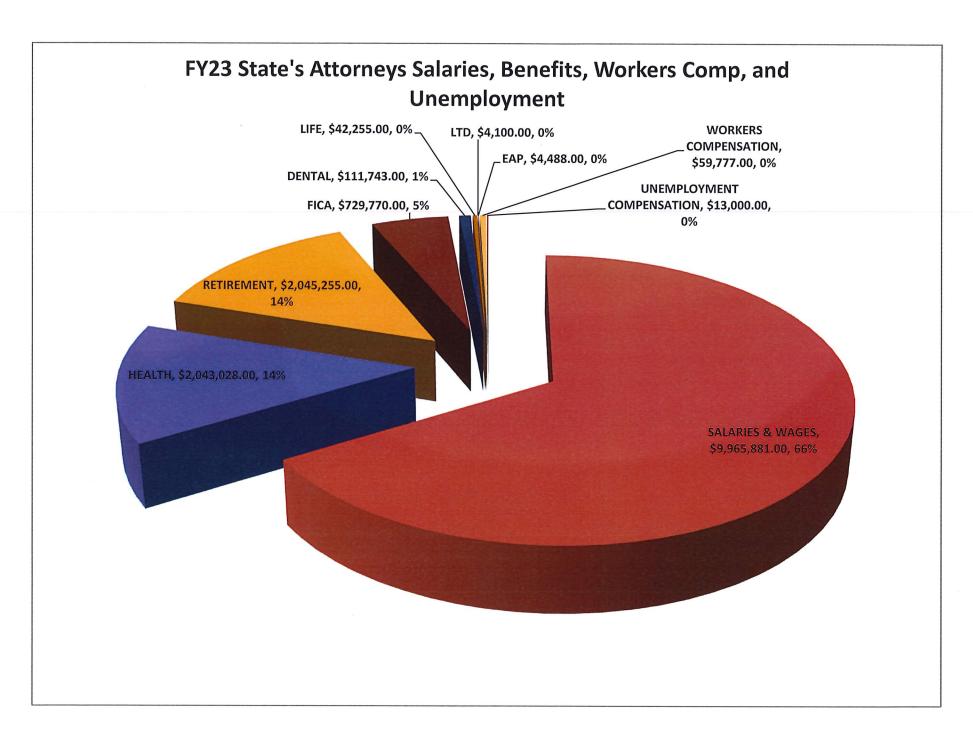
# FY23 GF \$14,358,352 4.46% increase in State General Fund

- Notable Issues and FY23 Budget Pressures
- GF increase \$612,575, but salary & benefit increases will total more than \$843,859\*----(projected prior to costing of tentative union contract agreement)
- Increased FFS \$74,905 (Caledonia)
- Union contract costs will requires full funding in the pay act
- Vacancy Savings required to meet budget \$331,160 (at a minimum)

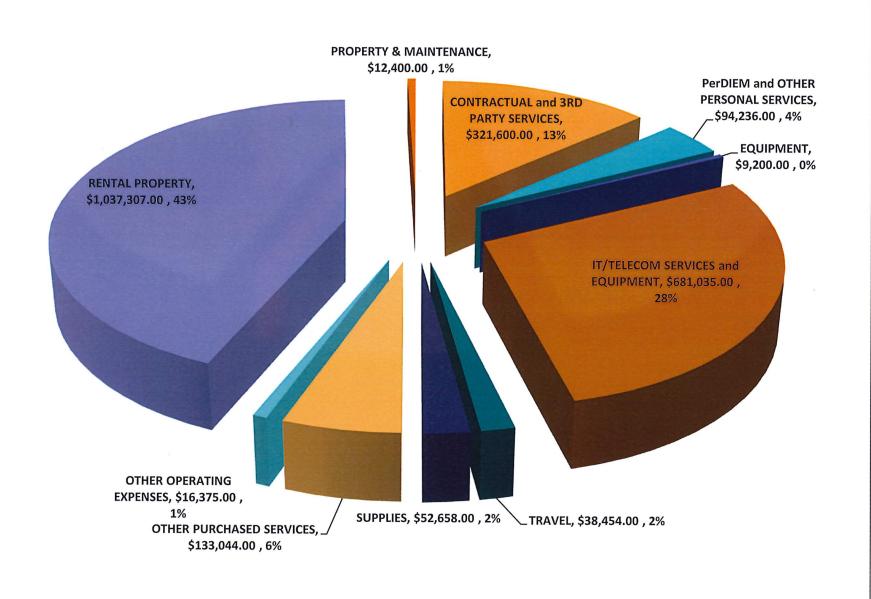
- Significant workload shift from Judiciary as a result of the Tyler Odyssey and E-file system, particularly to the SAS administrative support staff.
- Increased workload on SAO Attorneys and Victim Advocates from statutory changes in 2021 session, and proposed from 2022 session, including, but not limited to, sealing and expungement, victim notification in multiple bills, mid-point review.

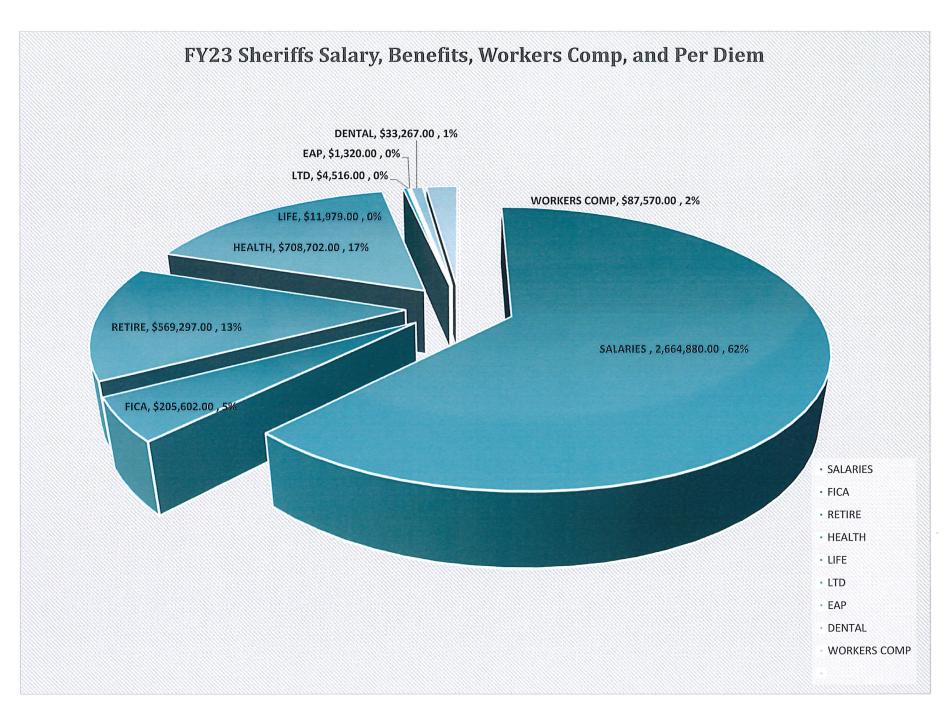

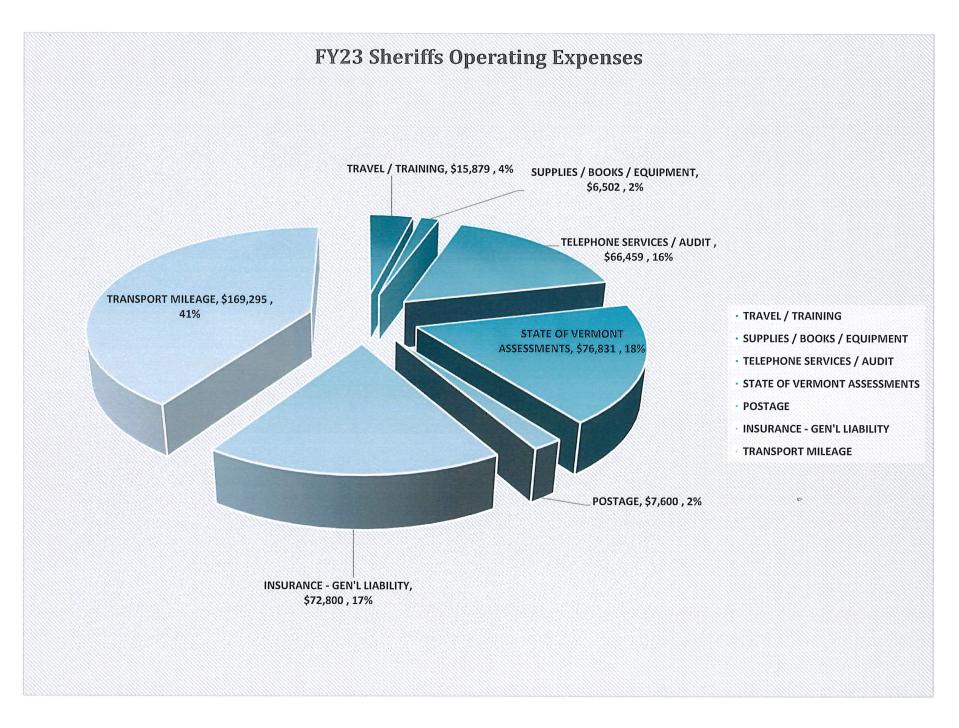

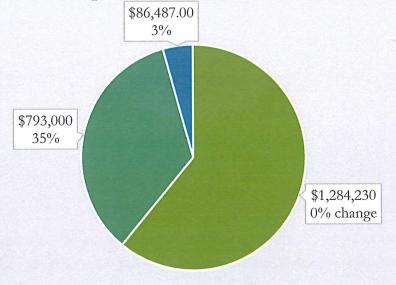
#### FY23 Pressures
