One graduate of our High School Completion Program sought our help because she could not progress further in her career without attaining her high school diploma. She had worked in a healthcare office for over twenty years, but was not considered for advancement because she was lacking this credential. This Vermonter had raised a family, owned a home, and been successful in so many of aspects of her life. Although she positively contributed to her local community in countless ways, this barrier held her back. While continuing to work fulltime, she met in the evenings for two years to improve her reading, language and math literacy skills. Together, we collaborated to create an individualized learning plan, including several online courses in areas that would build her resume. When she earned her diploma, she also earned a promotion at work. This one obstacle, that had held her back from her goals for so long, was finally gone. She not only increased her earning capacity, she gained confidence and pride in herself. This opportunity changed the quality of her life; she was able to build assets she will take with her in everything she does.
