**Subject: Veterans Waivers for Inspection Mechanic Certification – 2021**

In accordance with Act 119, Sec. 8 of 2018, the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles has gathered the following on the number of Vermont veterans applying for a waiver of the examination required to be certified as a Vermont Inspection Mechanic pursuant to 23 V.S.A § 1227(b)(2).

In order to be eligible for a waiver, a veteran must be a resident of Vermont and have been designated by the U.S. Armed Forces as a 91B Wheeled Vehicle Mechanic or equivalent, with at least one of the following certifications:

- A. ASE Diesel Mechanic;
- B. ASE Light Truck Engine Repair;
- C. ASE Automobile Service Consultant;
- D. Certified Hazardous Material Manager; or
- E. Associate Safety Professional
