7	following "Beginning on January 1, 2023," by striking out ", report annually"		
8	and inserting in lieu thereof ", submit an annual report"		
9	Fifth: By striking out Sec. 3, sunset of Corrections Monitoring		
10	Commission, in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new Sec. 3 to read as		
11	follows:
