7	(1) extend the deadline to December 31, 2022 for statewide adoption of
8	eFinancePlus;
9	(2) pause until January 1, 2022 the further implementation of
10	eFinancePlus to provide time for further evaluation of the system, provided
11	that:
12	(A) the Agency of Education and its contractor for implementation of
13	the system shall continue to support users of the system; and
14	(B) a supervisory union, supervisory district, school district, or
15	independent technical center district that does not use the system may join an
16	implementation round offered by the Agency of Education during the pause
17	period upon approval by its governing body;
18	(3) require the Agency of Education to issue status reports to the
19	General Assembly; and
20	(4) make adoption of eFinancePlus voluntary.

1	Second: In Sec. 15, 2018 (Sp. Sess.) Acts and Resolves No. 11, Sec.
2	E.500.1, by striking out subsection (a) in its entirety and inserting in lieu
3	thereof the following:
4	(a) Not later than July 1 December 31, 2022, all Vermont supervisory
5	unions, supervisory districts, school districts, and independent tech technical
6	center districts shall are encouraged to utilize the same school finance and
7	financial data management system. The system shall be selected by the
8	Agency of Education per State procurement guidelines.
