Every Child Off to a Good Start

- Literacy reform
- Move most of CDD to AOE
- Property tax exemption for PreK centers



All Students are Well Supported

- After school task force (in progress)
- Restructuring of responsibilities between AOE and SBOE



Equal Opportunity for All Students

- Curriculum required to address hate issues; model curriculum
- Mandatory policy to address racial equity
- Task force on school disciplinary procedures
- Statewide assessment of school facilities



Expand Learning Opportunities

- Simplify home study regulations
- Expand VTVLC
- Supervisory union contracting for enrollment exchange and course taking exchange



High Quality Instruction/Pipeline

- Automatic licensing reciprocity
- Eliminate online teaching endorsement
- Transfer adjudication of licensing appeals to OPR



Pathways Between Schools and CTEs

- Restructure CTE financing based on modeling done by Bill Talbot and Deb Brighton
 - Removes CTE tuition from school district budget
 - CTE centers have their own tax rate
 - Increase CTE block grant
 - Regional assessment based on overall regional population



Modernize Operations

- RFP for statewide student information system
- Regional back office pilot
- Uniform statewide school calendar with school starting after Labor Day
