ARP Indoor Air Quality: Eligible Entities

Change in language of Act 9, Section 15(a) to correct an error that inadvertently makes our CTE centers ineligible to receive ARP Indoor Air Quality funding to improve air quality.

Amend Act 9 language:

Appropriation. In fiscal year 2021, \$15,000,000.00 is appropriated from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 - Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund for the Pre-K-12 Education Pandemic - School Indoor Air Quality Grant Program established in 2020 Acts and Resolves No. 120, Sec. A.51, and amended to include regional CTE districts as defined in 16 VSA 1571 and regional CTE centers as defined in 16 VSA 1522.



Vaccine Incentive Program Funding

Request \$200,000 in ARPA SFRF funds to support the vaccine incentive program for independent schools (recognized and approved) that are *not* eligible to receive ESSER funds.

The period of performance for these funds is January 1, 2021 through June 30, 2021.

ESSER Set Aside Funds

Amend Act 174, Sections E.501.1(a) and E.501.2(b) to address newly identified priorities for the use of ESSER I funds (including vaccine incentive program ending June 30, 2021) and extend the period of performance for remote learning support funds in ARP ESSER. (Updated text highlighted in bold)

- a. Section E.501.1(a) amended to read:
 - (1) \$953,021 for software tools to assist with the response to the COVID-19 pandemic; (2) \$1,006,074 for learning management assistance, including remote learning supports and materials; (3) **\$1,000,000 for emerging state level needs**; and (4) \$155,741 for administrative and personnel costs
- b. Section E.501.2(b)(1) amended to read:
 - (1) \$1,000,000 from the ESSER funds provided to the State pursuant to Sec. 2001(f) of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Pub. L. No. 117-2 **for learning management assistance, including remote learning supports and materials; and** (2) \$1,425,821 from the ESSER funds provided to the State pursuant to Sec. 2001(f)(4) of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Pub. L. No. 117-2 for administrative and personnel costs.
