6	Sec. 72, effective date, in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof Secs. 72 and

8	Sec. 72. 21 V.S.A. § 491 is amended to read:
9	§ 491. ABSENCE ON MILITARY SERVICE AND TRAINING;
10	EMPLOYMENT AND REEMPLOYMENT RIGHTS
11	(a)(1) Any duly qualified member of the Reserve Components of the U.S.
12	Armed Forces, of the Ready Reserve, or an organized unit of the Vermont
13	National Guard or the National Guard of another state shall upon, when called
14	to state or federal service, receive the same benefits, privileges, and protections
15	in employment regardless of the activation authority or location of service.
16	(2)(A) Upon request, a duly qualified member of the Reserve
17	Components of the U.S. Armed Forces, of the Ready Reserve, or the Vermont
18	National Guard or the National Guard of another state shall be entitled to
19	leaves of absence for a total of 15 days in any calendar year for the purpose of
20	engaging a leave of absence to engage in military drill, training, or other

1	temporary duty under military authority pursuant to state or federal military
2	orders.
3	(B) A member of the Vermont National Guard or the National Guard
4	of any state or territory who is ordered to state active duty shall be subject to
5	the requirements of and entitled to the rights, privileges, benefits, and
6	protections provided by the Uniformed Services Employment and
7	Reemployment Rights Act (USERRA), 38 U.S.C. §§ 4301–4335.
8	(C) A leave of absence shall be with or without pay as determined by
9	the employer. Upon completion of the military drill, training, or other
10	temporary duty under military authority, a permanent employee shall be
11	reinstated in that position with the same status, pay, and seniority, including
12	seniority that accrued during the period of absence.
13	(b) A member of or an applicant for membership in the National Guard in
14	either federal or state status as defined in 20 V.S.A. §§ 366, and 601, or 602,
15	shall not be denied initial employment, reemployment, retention of
16	employment, promotion, or any benefit of employment by an employer on the
17	basis of membership, application for membership, performance of service,
18	application for service, or obligation to serve.
