12	(2) "Employee" means a person who is a crime victim as defined in
13	section 495d of this chapter and, in consideration of direct or indirect gain or
14	profit, has been continuously employed by the same employer for a period of
15	six months for an average of at least 20 hours per week.
16	(3) "Victim" has the same meaning as in 13 V.S.A. § 5301.
17	(b) In addition to the leave provided in section 472 of this title, an
18	employee shall be entitled to take unpaid leave from employment for the
19	purpose of attending a deposition or court proceeding related to:
20	(1) a criminal proceeding, when the employee is a victim as defined in
21	13 V.S.A. § 5301 identified as an alleged victim of a crime in an affidavit file

1	by a law enforcement official with a prosecuting attorney of competent state or
2	federal jurisdiction and the employee has a right or obligation to appear at the
3	proceeding;
