2 Representative Gannon of Wilmington moves that the House concur in the
3 Senate proposal of amendment with further proposals of amendment as
4 follows:

5 First: By striking out Sec. 3, 7 V.S.A. § 868, in its entirety and inserting in
6 lieu thereof the following:

7 Sec. 3. 7 V.S.A. § 868 is amended to read:

8 § 868. PROHIBITED PRODUCTS

9 (a) The following are prohibited products and may not be cultivated,
10 produced, or sold pursuant to a license issued under this chapter:

11 (1) cannabis flower with greater than 30 percent tetrahydrocannabinol;

12 (2) ~~solid concentrate cannabis products with greater than 60 percent~~
13 ~~tetrahydrocannabinol;~~

14 (3) ~~oil cannabis products except for those that are sold prepackaged for~~
15 ~~use with battery-powered devices;~~

16 (4) flavored oil cannabis products sold prepackaged for use with battery-
17 powered devices and any cannabis flower that contains characterizing flavor
18 that is not naturally occurring in the cannabis;

19 (5)(3) cannabis products that contain delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol and
20 nicotine or alcoholic beverages; and

1 ~~(6)(4)~~ any cannabis, cannabis products, or packaging of such items that
2 are designed to make the product more appealing to persons under 21 years
3 of age.

4 (b)(1) Except as provided by subdivision (2) of this subsection, solid and
5 liquid concentrate cannabis products with greater than 60 percent
6 tetrahydrocannabinol may be produced by a licensee and sold to another
7 licensee in accordance with subchapter 3 of this chapter but shall not be sold to
8 the public by a licensed retailer.

9 (2) Liquid concentrate cannabis products with greater than 60 percent
10 tetrahydrocannabinol that are prepackaged for use with battery-powered
11 devices shall be permitted to be sold to the public by a licensed retailer.

12 Second: By adding a new section to be Sec. 12a to read as follows:

13 Sec. 12a. 7 V.S.A. § 910(8) is amended to read:

14 (8) Products. ~~Retailers and integrated licensees~~ Cannabis establishments
15 licensed by the Board shall be assessed an annual product licensing fee of
16 \$50.00 for every type of cannabis and cannabis product that is sold in
17 accordance with this chapter.
