§ 907. RETAILER LICENSE Sec. (e) is amended to read:

- On or before September 1st, 2022 the Cannabis Control Board is to accept Cannabis Delivery Operator License applications exclusively from Social Equity Applicants (as defined by the CCB) who hold no other cannabis business licenses.
- On or before October 1st 2022, The Cannabis Control Board is to issue Cannabis Delivery Operator licenses. At this time, the Cannabis Control Board will authorize the use of online ordering.
- From October 1st 2022 to October 1st 2025, Delivery Operator licenses would be available only to Social Equity Applicants who do not hold another license in the state.
- On or after October 1st 2025, delivery licenses would be available exclusively to Social Equity Applicants, regardless of other license holdings.
- On or before October 1st 2032, delivery licenses become available to the general public regardless of Social Equity status or holdings of other licenses.
- Cannabis Delivery Operator licensee's may purchase finished cannabis products, accessories, and branded goods at wholesale price from a license wholesaler, retailer or dispensary and Whitelabel those products and sell them directly to consumers and medical patients.
- During the application process, delivery applicants would be required to submit the following information:
 - Business name
 - Tax ID
 - Contact information
 - Physical location of business where cannabis products may be stored
 - Social Equity Applicant status
 - Person(s) having equity in the company
 - Business plan including:
 - Plan for obtaining limited liability insurance
 - How the licensee will accept orders online
 - Third Party Technology Providers, wholesalers, retail and dispensaries they hope to partner with
 - All vehicles involved in the company including:

- Make
- Model
- Year
- VIN
- Insurance Policy Number
