2 Representative Gannon of Wilmington moves that the House propose to the
3 Senate that the report of the Committee on Government Operations be
4 amended by striking out Sec. 17, 20 V.S.A. § 2358, in its entirety and inserting
5 in lieu thereof a new Sec. 17 to read as follows:

6 Sec. 17. VERMONT CRIMINAL JUSTICE COUNCIL; ARIDE REPORT

7 On or before October 1, 2021, the Vermont Criminal Justice Council shall
8 report to the House and Senate Committees on Appropriations and on
9 Government Operations on the following:

10 (1) the funding for the requirement that on or before December 31, 2021 all
11 law enforcement officers receive Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving
12 Enforcement (ARIDE) training as required by 2019 Acts and Resolves No.
13 164, Sec. 20; and

14 (2) a recommendation as to which law enforcement officers, if any, should
15 not be required to receive ARIDE training because those officers do not make
16 roadside stops or those officers would not be proficient in the standardized
17 field sobriety test that is a prerequisite of ARIDE training because of their law
18 enforcement position or training.
