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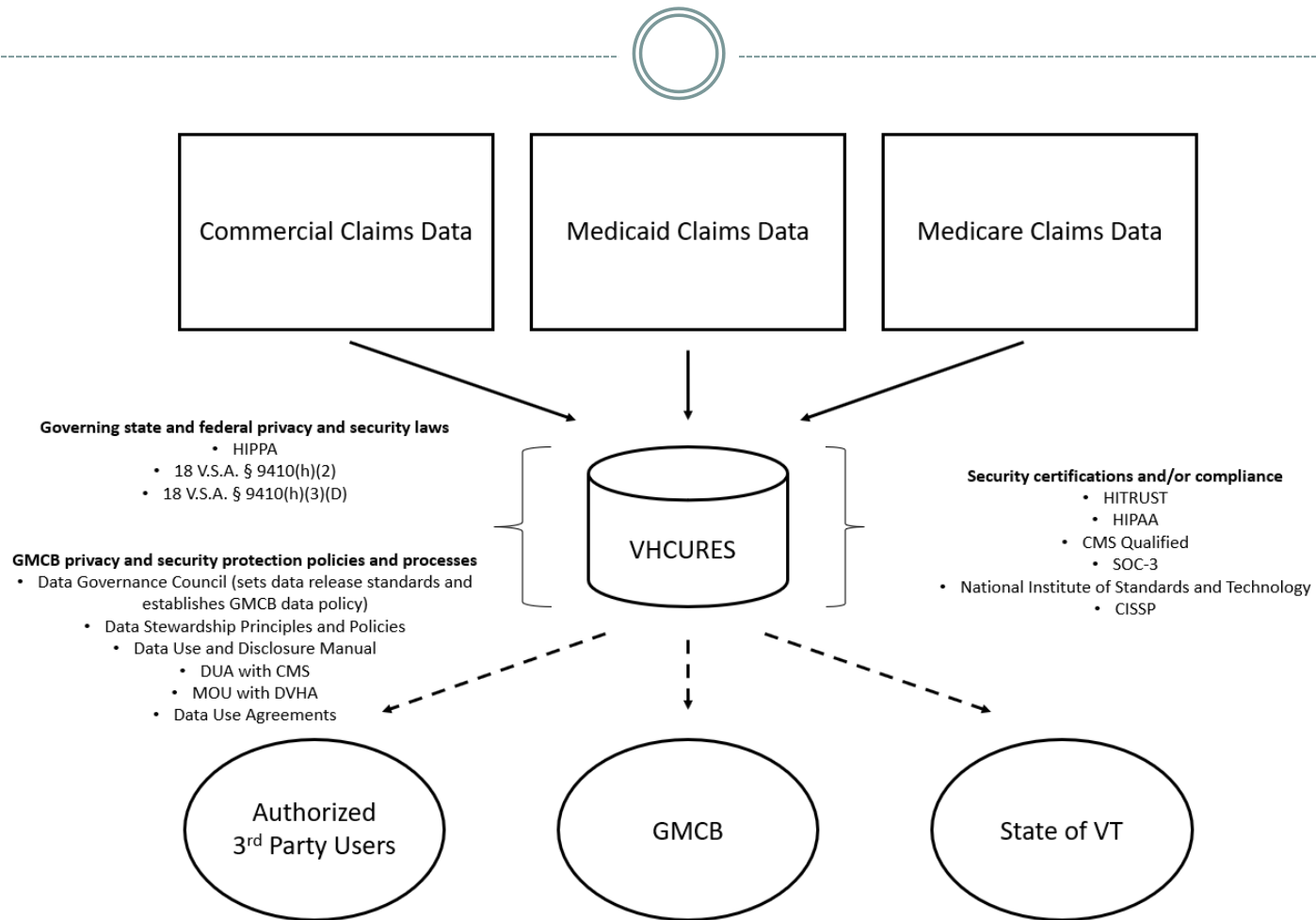

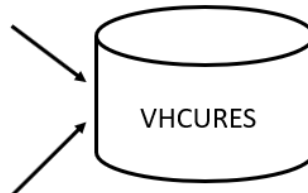

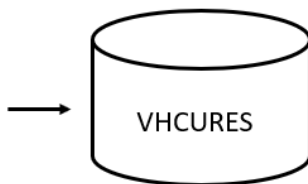

What GMCB, VT, and 3rd Parties See



Take-away Points: Section 5 of S.285



- S.285 Sec. 5 changes how **payers submit** data to VHCURES.
- S.285 Sec. 5 changes what VHCURES data can be linked to.
- **S.285 Sec. 5 does not change the what data the GMCB, the state, or authorized 3rd parties see.**
