

1 TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

2 The Committee on Human Services to which was referred Senate Bill No.  
3 206 entitled “An act relating to planning and support for individuals and  
4 families impacted by Alzheimer’s Disease and related disorders” respectfully  
5 reports that it has considered the same and recommends that the House propose  
6 to the Senate that the bill be amended by inserting a new section with reader  
7 assistance heading to be Sec. 6a to read as follows:

8 \* \* \* Missing Persons with Alzheimer’s Disease;  
9 Response Communications \* \* \*

10 Sec. 6a. DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY; MISSING PERSONS  
11 EMERGENCY RESPONSE AND COMMUNICATIONS; REPORT

12 On or before November 1, 2022, the Department of Public Safety shall  
13 submit a written report to the House Committee on Human Services, the  
14 Senate Committee on Health and Welfare, and the House and Senate  
15 Committees on Government Operations with its recommendations regarding  
16 broadcasting information on missing persons with Alzheimer’s Disease or  
17 related disorders or cognitive disabilities to aid in locating those individuals,  
18 including any proposals for legislative action. In forming its  
19 recommendations, the Department shall consult with interested stakeholders,  
20 including the Vermont Chapter of the Alzheimer’s Association, Vermont Care  
21 Partners, and the Vermont Association on Mental Health and Addiction

1 Recovery, and shall notify the Chairs of the House Committee on Human  
2 Services, the Senate Committee on Health and Welfare, and the House and  
3 Senate Committees on Government Operations as to the date, time, and  
4 location of stakeholder meetings.
