14	§ 4001. DEFINITIONS
15	As used in this chapter:
16	* * *
17	(6) "Education spending" means the amount of the school district
18	budget, any assessment for a joint contract school, career technical center
19	payments made on behalf of the district under subsection 1561(b) of this title,
20	and any amount added to pay a deficit pursuant to 24 V.S.A. § 1523(b) that is

1	paid for by the school district, but excluding any portion of the school budget
2	paid for from any other sources such as endowments, parental fundraising,
3	federal funds, nongovernmental grants, or other State funds such as special
4	education funds paid under chapter 101 of this title.
5	(A) [Repealed.]
6	(B) For purposes of calculating excess spending pursuant to
7	32 V.S.A. § 5401(12), "education spending" shall not include:
8	(i) Spending during the budget year for:
9	(I) approved school capital construction for a project that
10	received preliminary approval under section 3448 of this title, including
11	interest paid on the debt, provided the district shall not be reimbursed or
12	otherwise receive State construction aid for the approved school capital
13	construction; or
14	(II) eligible school capital construction project costs pursuant to
15	the State Board of Education's Rule 6134.
16	(ii) For a project that received final approval for State construction
17	aid under chapter 123 of this title:
18	(I) spending for approved school capital construction during the
19	budget year that represents the district's share of the project, including interest
20	paid on the debt; and or

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1	(II) payment during the budget year of interest on funds
2	borrowed under subdivision 563(21) of this title in anticipation of receiving
3	State aid for the project.
4	(iii) Spending that is approved school capital construction
5	spending or deposited into a reserve fund under 24 V.S.A. § 2804 to pay future
6	approved school capital construction costs, including that portion of tuition
7	paid to an independent school designated as the public high school of the
8	school district pursuant to section 827 of this title for capital construction costs
9	by the independent school that has received approval from the State Board of
10	Education, using the processes for preliminary approval of public school
11	construction costs pursuant to subdivision 3448(a)(2) of this title.
