2 The Committee on Appropriations to which was referred Senate Bill No.
3 250 entitled “An act relating to law enforcement data collection and
4 interrogation” respectfully reports that it has considered the same and
5 recommends that the report of the Committee on Government Operations be
6 amended the bill be amended in Sec. 4, study on deceptive and coercive
7 methods of law enforcement interrogation; report by striking out subsection (b)
8 and inserting in lieu thereof a new subsection (b):

9 Sec. 4. STUDY ON DECEPTIVE AND COERCIVE METHODS OF LAW
10 ENFORCEMENT INTERROGATION; REPORT

12 (b) The Committee shall have the administrative, technical assistance, and
13 legal assistance of the Office of Legislative Counsel. The Committee may
14 have the assistance of the Vermont Criminal Justice Council in drafting the
15 report, along with any other stakeholders interested in assisting. On or before
16 December 1, 2022, the Committee shall submit a report on the study providing
17 legislative recommendations, proposed next steps, no legislative changes are
18 needed, or that the study is incomplete.
