FY 2022 Summary & Highlights

- New audit position approved by the Leg. in 2020 but it remains vacant (4 Exempt, 12 Classified)
- After years of inflation-adjusted declines, we have no option but to present a budget that features increases (see the Feb. 10 memo for details)
- 9.4% increase in General Fund
- 13.5% increase in Single Audit Revolving Fund
- CliftonLarsonAllen (CLA) contract extended for the CAFR and Single Audits
- We have identified over \$33 million in potential savings, cost recovery & uncollected assessments since 2013
- Good results implementing our audit recommendations at AOE, AHS & DEC; BGS making progress, but DHR & DVHA are not doing as well
- Repeat findings and re-audits remain down in the Single Audit thanks in part to F&M
