VCRD Update on Working Lands Enterprise Fund Request

- Brian Lowe, VCRD from working lands coalition
- \$15 million grant spent over the next 4 year
- Significant unmet need
 - FY 2022 Even with over \$7.5 millions of allocation, significant unmet need
- Focus on climate change and working lands
- Charlie what do you think annual funding from state budget should be?
 - Baseline \$3 million at least year
 - Hoping for a \$15 million grant to help backlog lead

VT Creative Network Presentation

- Karen Mittelman
 - Creative district is foundational to VT economy?
- Pandemic impact on creative sector lost 8000 jobs
- Most concerned with smaller arts businesses/organizations
- Grants
 - \$10 M for operating support and recovery
 - \$4M for facility adaptations COVID safe
 - \$2M transitional costs requiring implementing safe public programing
- Creative Spaces Grants
 - o \$750K to restore vitality to vacant buildings in downtown and villages
 - \$500K support state and regional marketing of arts and cultural events
 - \$250 to implement CreateVT act
- Questions

 - What is the status of this bill?

 - Example Brandon Town of 4,000 people opera house, forprofit music center, artist galleries
