2 Representative Coffey of Guilford moves that the House concur in the
3 Senate proposal of amendment with further proposals of amendment as
4 follows:

5 First: In Sec. 2, 28 V.S.A. § 123, in subsection (b), in subdivision (1),
6 following “shall be composed of the following,” by striking out “nine” and
7 inserting in lieu thereof “eight”

8 Second: In Sec. 2, 28 V.S.A. § 123, in subsection (b), in subdivision (1), by
9 striking out subdivisions (F)–(H) in their entireties and inserting in lieu thereof
10 the following:

11 (F) a former management-level employee of the Department of
12 Corrections with experience in corrections management, appointed by the
13 Governor; and

14 (G) an individual at large with knowledge of and experience in the
15 correctional system, crime prevention, human resources, or compliance,
16 appointed by the Governor.

17 Third: In Sec. 2, 28 V.S.A. § 123, in subsection (c), in subdivision (2),
18 following “The Commission may,” by striking out “interview current
19 Department employees and individuals in the custody of the Department,
20 review exit interview records for former Department employees” and inserting
21 in lieu thereof “engage with current and former Department employees and

1 individuals in the custody of the Department, review the Analysis of State of
2 Vermont Employee Engagement Survey Results from the Department of
3 Human Resources”

4 Fourth: In Sec. 2, 28 V.S.A. § 123, in subsection (c), in subdivision (4),
5 following “Beginning on January 1, 2023,” by striking out “, report annually”
6 and inserting in lieu thereof “, submit an annual report”

7 Fifth: By striking out Sec. 3, sunset of Corrections Monitoring
8 Commission, in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new Sec. 3 to read as
9 follows:

10 Sec. 3. SUNSET OF CORRECTIONS MONITORING COMMISSION

11 REPORT; SUNSET OF COMMISSION

12 (a) 28 V.S.A. § 123(c)(4) (Commission report) is repealed on July 1, 2024.

13 (b) 28 V.S.A. § 123 (Department of Corrections Monitoring Commission)
14 is repealed on July 1, 2025.

15 Sixth: In Sec. 4, implementation of the Corrections Monitoring
16 Commission, in subsection (c), in subdivision (1), by striking out subdivisions
17 (F)–(H) in their entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

18 (F) the Governor shall appoint a member to fill the position
19 designated in subdivision (b)(1)(F) of Sec. 2 of this act for a two-year term;

20 and

- 1 (G) the Governor shall appoint a member to fill the position
- 2 designated in subdivision (b)(1)(G) of Sec. 2 of this act for a one-year term.
