2 Representative Emmons of Springfield moves that the House concur with
3 the Senate Proposal of Amendment with further proposal of amendment as
4 follows:

5 First: In Sec. 4, commerce and community development, by striking out
6 subsection (d) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 (d) For the amount appropriation in subdivision (a)(2), not more than
8 \$10,000 shall be used as follows:

9 (1) to open two new underwater preserves at the Potash Point Canalboat
10 Site and the Pine Street Barge Canal Breakwater Graveyard Site; and

11 (2) prepare documentation for the Isle La Motte Wreck site and the
12 Providence Island Wreck site.

13 Second: By adding a Sec. 21a to read as follows:

14 Sec. 21a. 13 BALDWIN STREET; SALE OF PROPERTY

15 The Commissioner of Buildings and General Services is authorized to sell
16 the property located at 13 Baldwin Street in Montpelier, Vermont pursuant to
17 the requirements of 29 V.S.A. § 166. The proceeds from the sale shall be
18 appropriated to future capital construction projects.

1 Fourth: By striking out all after Sec. 30, 24 V.S.A. § 4764, and inserting in
2 lieu thereof the following:

3 Sec. 31. MORATORIUM ON LAKE ENCROACHMENT PERMITS FOR
4 SINKING OF VESSEL

5 Notwithstanding the authority of the Department of Environmental
6 Conservation (Department) under 29 V.S.A. chapter 11 to authorize
7 encroachments on lakes and ponds and lands lying thereunder, the Department
8 shall not issue a lake encroachment permit for the intentional sinking of a
9 vessel in any lake or pond within the jurisdiction of the Department during the
10 period beginning on the effective date of this act and ending on July 1, 2024.

12 the following space:

13 (1) 2 Aiken Street: Entire building.

14 (2) 4 Aiken Street: Entire building.

16 (c) The Sergeant at Arms and the Commissioner of Buildings and General
17 Services shall consider ways to address any disruption to the functionality of
18 the Executive and Legislative Branches in shared State building space.

20 shall apply in any rooms or spaces occupied by the Legislative Branch.

1 Sec. 33. LEGISLATIVE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON THE STATE
2 HOUSE; STATE HOUSE LEGISLATIVE SPACE AND DESIGN; REPORT

3 (a)(1) The Legislative Advisory Committee on the State House shall review
4 and make recommendations on any space and design proposals for the State
5 House. The review shall take into account the Freeman, French, and Freeman,
6 Legislative Space Study, 2021-2022, dated April 26, 2021. Prior to making
7 any recommendations, the Committee shall consult with legislators, legislative
8 staff, and relevant stakeholders on space needs.

9 (2) The Committee shall have the assistance of a planning architect.

10 (b) On or before August 15, 2021, the Committee shall submit a report with
11 its recommendations to the Joint Legislative Management Committee, the Joint
12 Rules Committee, the House Committee on Corrections and Institutions, and
13 the Senate Committee on Institutions.

19 the requirements of 29 V.S.A. § 166. The proceeds from the sale shall be
20 appropriated to future capital construction projects.
