Reports and Data

Population Data:

- Daily Population Report: includes counts of incarcerated individuals at correctional facilities by booking status and sex
- Population Characteristics Report: point-in-time analyses of the incarcerated population including crime, demographic, and facility breakdowns

Release Reports:

- Release Report: includes longitudinal analyses of incarcerated individuals who were released from corrections
- Minimum Release Report: point-in-time analyses regarding minimum release information for incarcerated individuals, including data for those held past minimum release

Special Topics:

- **Cross Topic Reports:** detailed information from the Population Characteristics, Violent Crime, and Minimum Release reports across the following topics, separately:
 - o Gender
 - o Race
 - o Serious Functional Impairment (SFI)-Designation
- **Violent Crime Reports:** point-in-time analyses regarding listed crime information (as a proxy for crimes that are violent in nature) for incarcerated individuals
